- How do the beginning verses of Exodus (1:7) show that God is keeping the promise to Abram in Genesis 1:28?

Exodus 1-4 – Pharaoh tries to destroy Israel

- What justifications does Pharaoh use for his actions?
- How does Pharaoh's action demonstrate the inability to discern good from evil?
- How does the story of Moses as an infant show that Pharaoh's plan will not succeed?

Exodus 5-15 – Confrontation between God & Pharaoh

- How does Pharaoh respond to the opportunities given to him to repent?
- What does this tell us about the hardening of Pharaoh's heart?
- What does this tell us about what God and human choices?
- What message does this have for us?

Passover:

- What did Passover mean to the Israelites?
- How do we have a new understanding of Passover in Jesus?

The final showdown:

- In what different ways has God rescued the people?
- What does the Song of the Sea tell us about God's purposes?
- Could Moses have freed his people from Pharaoh on his own?
- What did God do – what was Moses' role?

Exodus 16-18 – In the Wilderness

- How do the people respond once things get difficult?
- How does God respond?
- What do we start to learn about Israel – and about ourselves in their response?

God's Covenant with Israel

- What was God's promise to Abraham?
- What is God's intention for Israel and how does it relate to the rest of the nations?

Exodus 19-24 – God's Covenant with Israel

- How do the Ten Commandments fit in with the covenant?
- What are the other laws supposed to be about?
- What is the response of the people?
- Why does the Sanctuary (Tabernacle) Matter? How does it connect to the consequence of the Fall?

Exodus 25-31 – The Tabernacle Blueprint

- What is the purpose of all the symbolism in the Tabernacle – what is it meant to remind us of?

Exodus 32-34 – Israel Breaks The Covenant

- What causes the people to create an idol?
- What commands have they immediately broken?
- How does Moses intercede with God on behalf of the people?
- How does God describe God's own character?
 - o What is the tension of God's character and being in relationship with human beings?

Exodus 35-40 – Moses Builds the Tabernacle

- Why does it matter that God's presence filled the temple?
- Why can't Moses enter?
- How did the book begin?
- What is the ending of the book telling us?
- What is the question we are left with at the end of the book?
