- Describe the actions and attitudes of those who belong to this kingdom
- Why is there resistance this message and ministry?

Luke 9:18-27 Jesus asserts his messianic identity

- How will Jesus fulfill this identity (and based on what OT scripture)?

Luke 9:28-36 The Transfiguration

- Why are Moses and Elijah present on the mountain? What is this saying about Jesus' identity and mission?

Luke 9b-19a Journey to Jeruslaem

- How does Luke portray what it is like to follow Jesus?
(how is this different than a class you can 'graduate' from?)

- What is the importance of the Emmaus story?
- When do they recognize Jesus
- How does Jesus' resurrection meal with the disciples help them see the big picture?
- What are the disciples to do at the end of the Gospel of Luke?
